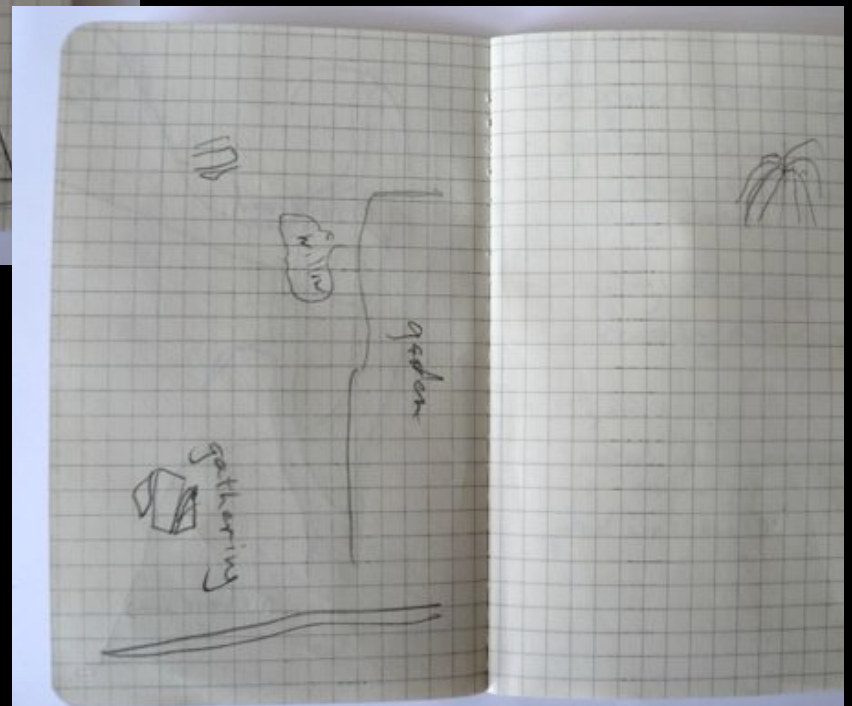
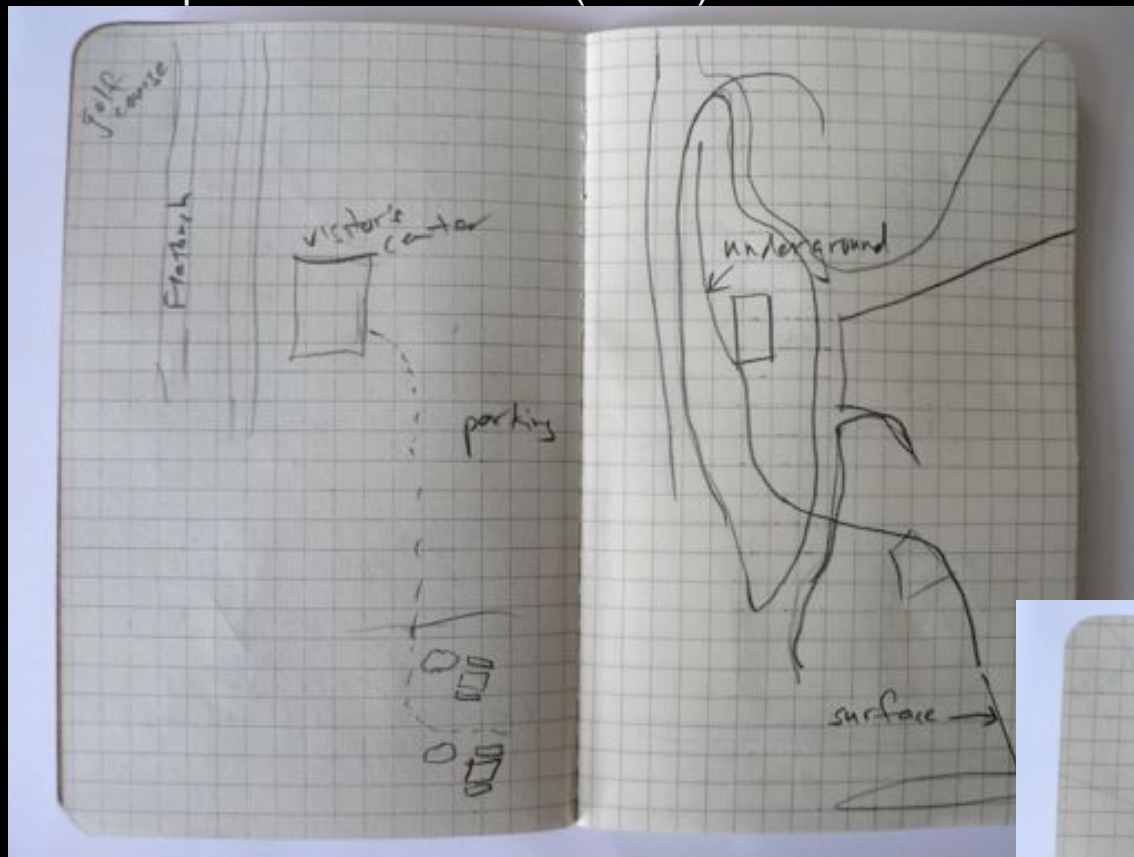

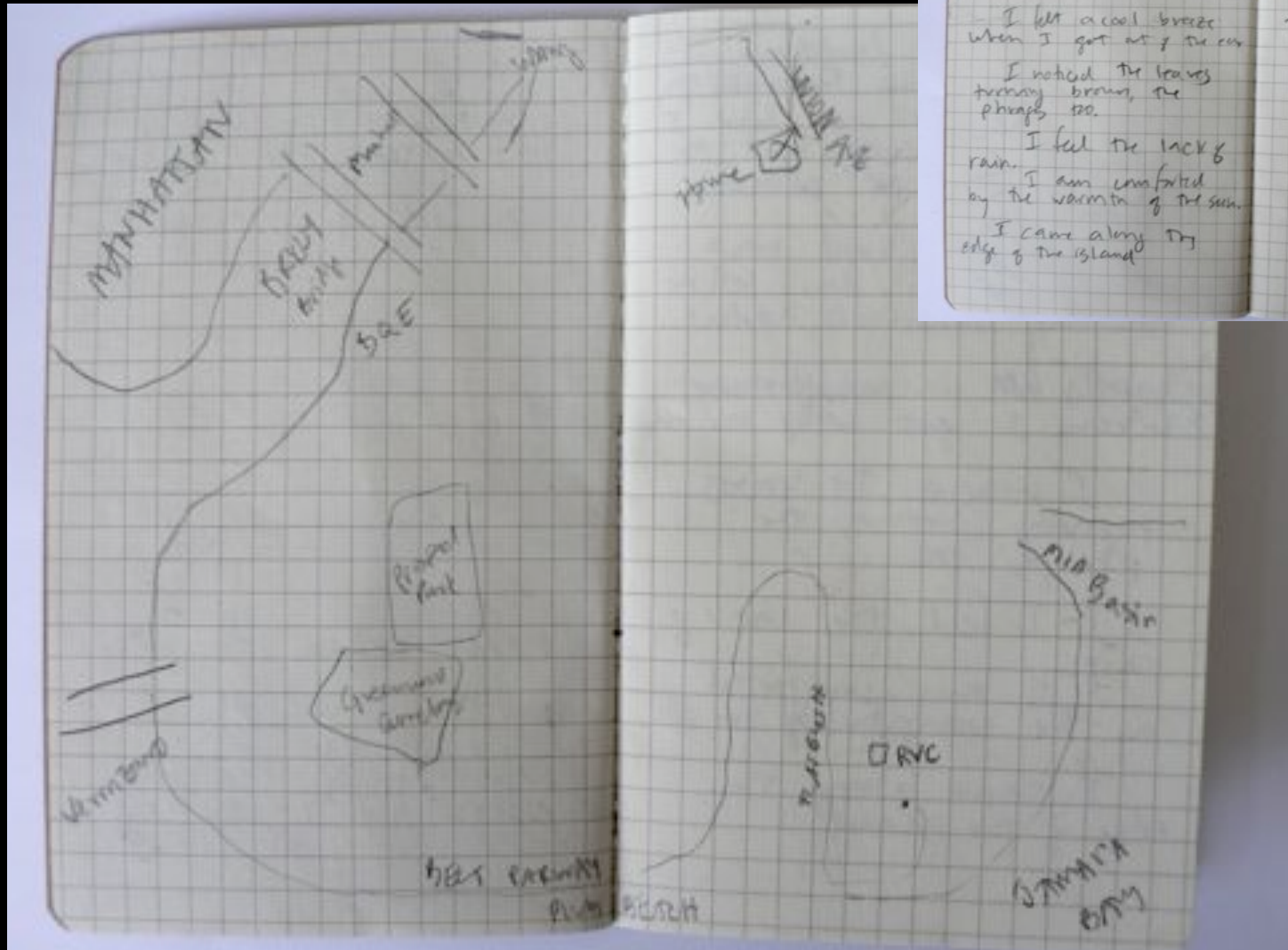

I came along the edge of the island

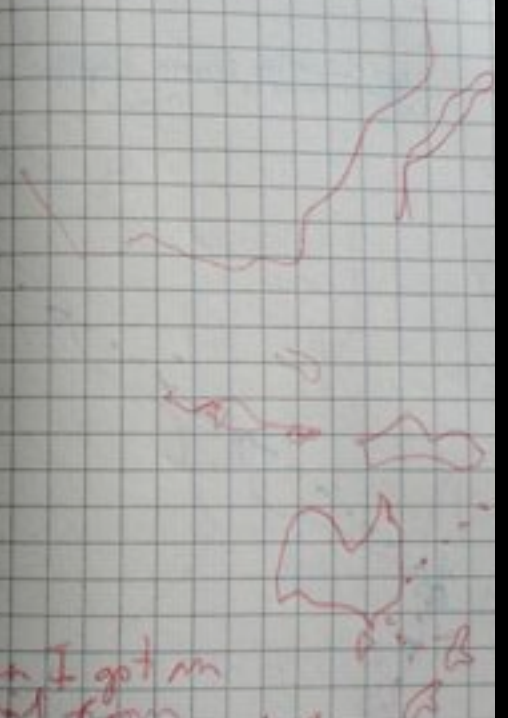

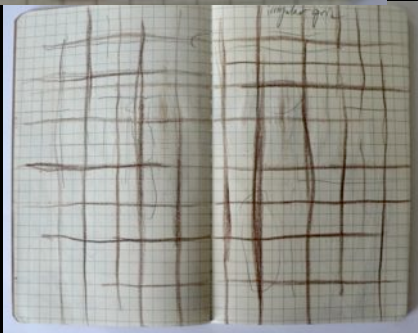
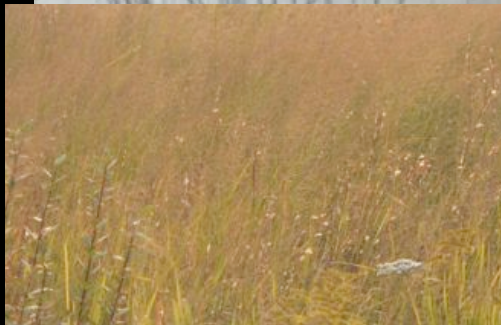


# Runway 'Rooms'/Perspective
